
WHO WE ARE

LEVELS OF CARE

CRISIS SERVICES address the needs of individuals who are dealing with a traumatic event or life crisis, and those facing an acute episode of a psychiatric or substance use disorder. Crisis counseling and our suicide hotline are here to help. Clients may also be referred to outpatient treatment or admission to medically supervised, inpatient services. However, Meridian is not a hospital, so our inpatient units cannot accommodate those needing significant medical or surgical care.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICES provide longer-term treatment, focusing on counseling, support, and rehabilitation to promote recovery and your successful return to the community. These programs offer 24-hour care and primarily serve those with serious substance use disorders and/or persistent mental illness.

OUTPATIENT SERVICES provide treatment, education, and supportive services that address mild-to-moderate illness and/or support sustained recovery. Our therapists use a range of tools that are evidence-based and effective in treating these situations. Services can be provided in any of our clinics, in school or home, or via Telehealth.

COMMUNITY

OUTREACH seeks to share Meridian's story with all of North Central Florida. Identifying and engaging with community members who may need our support and services to help them reach their personal goals toward recovery and wellness.

PREVENTION aims to educate and inform the community of the risk factors for mental illness or substance use. The overall goal being to stop the worsening of these illnesses at the earliest possible sign. These efforts also include training the community about Mental Health First Aid (MHFA), an evidence-based educational program for various age groups.

SPONSORED SERVICES AND ENTITIES provide additional support, through partnerships with other healthcare and social service organizations, to those affected by mental illnesses or substance use disorders.

BUSINESS SERVICES are also offered through a variety of employee assistance programs (EAP) and consultation. We also lead MHFA trainings for groups and individual community members.







Meridian accepts payment for services from a variety of sources: client fees, insurance, Medicaid, and Medicare. Services to those without insurance are partially funded by the Florida Department of Children and Families via LSF Health Systems, LLC.
