Reaching Recovery through...

- Built-in reinforcements for positive behaviors and consequences for maladaptive behaviors are set in place.
- Behavior modification therapy using a point-level system
- Structured and regulated days including school, treatment groups, and recreational activities.
- Individual, group, and family therapy.
- Regular participation in Meridian's Ropes Challenge Course.

 Program components include the
12-step model, motivation enhancement, and cognitive behavioral therapy.

The RECOVERY CENTER

is an 18-bed residential, substance abuse treatment program for adolescents - ages 13 to 17.

The programs consists of counseling, supportive services, education and medical services in a structured environment. Working towards developing healthy coping and problem-solving skills to deal with family or personal life problems.

Making Education A PRIORITY

School attendance is one of the mandatory requirements for all youth participating in the program.

During their stay at Meridian, participants are enrolled in the **Columbia County School System** and attend classes at the recovery center through the **Edgenuity** program.

With a **GED** option available, contingent upon parent approval; and "credit recovery" assistance for those who have fallen behind; Meridian makes academic success attainable for all participants.
